- The abstract must be written in English and contain no more than 2200 characters (spaces included), title of abstract and author(s) are not included.
- The following headings should be included AIM(S), METHOD(S), RESULTS, CONCLUSION
- Please use upper-case letters for the headings and lower-case letters in general. Minimum 12 pt.
- Title of abstract. Maximum 125 characters.
- Author (s). List all authors and their university, town and country affiliation; Family name first letter
 of first name comma university affiliation comma the university town comma country of university
 dot. If several authors please, separate with a semicolon e.g; Koch L, Karolinska Institutet, Stockholm,
 Sweden; Gustavsson C, Uppsala University, Uppsala, Sweden. Presenting author should be marked
 with an asterisk*
