

To consider before choice of contraception

1. How would I deal with a pregnancy if it were to occur at the moment?

2. For how long am I planning to use a contraception?

- Less than 1 year?
- More than 1 year? Especially important to use an effective contraceptive method.

Long-acting reversible contraceptive methods are at no cost/subsidized if you are below 26 years of age.

3. How do I experience my menstrual pain?
