Recent data on exercise effect on pCR

At the San Antonio Breast Cancer Symposium 2022, a subset analysis from the LEANer study presented data on 73 women receiving neoadjuvant chemotherapy, who were randomized to a home-based dietary and physical exercise intervention or usual care. At surgery, overall pCR was 52.5% in the intervention arm versus 28.1% in the usual care arm (p = 0.037). https://clinicaltrials.gov/ct2/show/NCT03314688?ter m=LEANer&cond=Breast+Cancer&draw=2&rank=1
