In the international and highly respected QS-ranking 2016 nursing at Karolinska Institutet was ranked number one in Europe and number five in the World. The ranking implies a good reputation and high quality of our research.

Parts of the programs consist of integrated practice learning in collaboration with the Stockholm County Council and the municipalities.
