Goal 3 – what we have learned?

- We have started to measure other kinds of mobility (degree projects, traineeships, courses that are partially given abroad, for example the interprofessional course in Global Health) to get a better picture of the international exposure our students get
- We must find new exchange opportunities for students who can only be mobile for periods shorter than five weeks.

Mål 4: Recruit 200 highly merited non-Eu students

Goal was achieved in 2016

- HT2018 32% fee paying students at the Global Masters
- HT2018: 471 applications /per masterprogram, 69% of applications from non-EU students → KI has Swedens most popular Masters program
