## **Decision SFO-V call for travel grants 2018**

The Strategic Research Area Health Care Science (SFO-V) launched a call for travel grant applications on up to SEK 50 K each in order to encourage international exchange and collaboration in the field of health care science within the SFO-V four core areas. The funding is intended to cover travel costs, living expenses and accommodation not covered by other funding for a stay of maximum three months. The total sum granted should be used during 2018-19, unless deductible time for parental leave, military service or long-term sick-leave can be proven. A written report on the outcome of the research visit is expected from SFO-V.

Fourteen applications were submitted and assessed according to criteria stated in the call for applications. The SFO-V steering group decided to award nine travel grants to the following applicants whose proposals were in accordance with the criteria:

- Daniel Berglind, 49 000,- to Norwegian School of Sport Sciences, Oslo
- Anna Jervaeus, 50 000,- to the Hongkong Polytechnic University
- Ann-Helen Patomella, 49 792,- to University of Sydney, Australia
- Sverker Johansson, 39 000,- to Aarhus University, Denmark
- David Conradsson, 50 000,- to University of the Western Cape, South Africa
- John Ovreteit, 50 000,- to Kaiser Permanente, Pasadena, CA, USA
- Hanne Konradssen, 42 238,- to the Hongkong Polytechnic University
- Ing-Marie Dohrn, 50 000,- to University of Queensland, Australia and Arizona State University, USA
- Cecilia Moberg, 49 200,- to Hongkong Polytechnic University

Five applications could not be granted since they did not fulfill one or more criteria stated in the call for applications.
