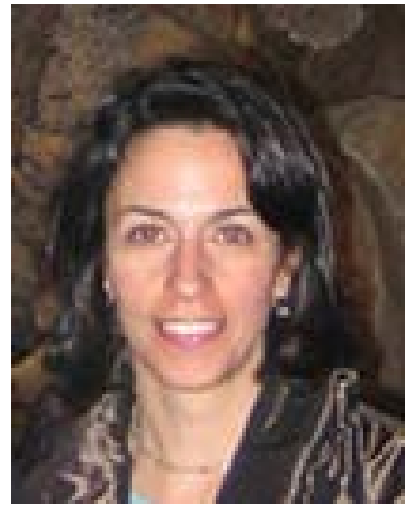

Apoptosis meets metabolism: A role for the Bcl-2 family protein BAD in nutrient sensing

Nika Danial, Dana Farber Cancer Institute, Harvard Medical School

The focus of Dr. Danial's group is to delineate cellular energy and nutrient sensing pathways, including metabolic checkpoints that integrate cellular survival and bioenergetics. They recently discovered that the proapoptotic protein BAD has an alternative role in reciprocal programming of glucose vs. fatty acids and ketone body metabolism.



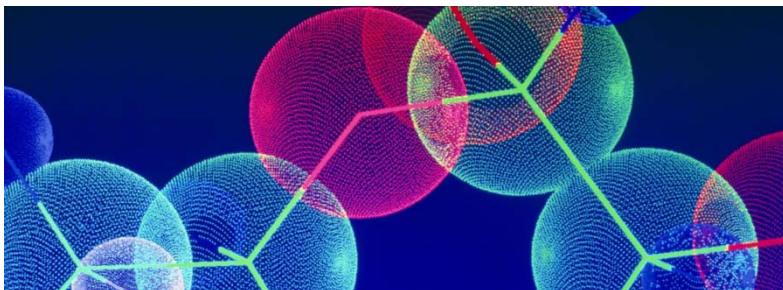
